

## 500w Socket - 2amp





500W Sockets will usually power: TVs (up to around 42") Phone Chargers Laptop/Tablet Charging (Please check where possible the name plate on your appliance to find the wattage consumption)




## 1KW Socket - 4amp

1KW Sockets will usually power: TV's (up to around 60") Lighting providing it doesn't exceed 1000W Small Under Counter Fridge (Please check where possible the name plate on your appliance to find the wattage consumption)



## 2KW Socket - 8amp



2KW Sockets will usually power: Small Domestic Microwaves Small Domestic Coffee Machines

(Please check where possible the name plate on your appliance to find the wattage consumption)



## 3KW Socket - 12amp



3KW Sockets will usually power: A Kettle, An Iron Large Domestic & Some Commercial Coffee Machines Appliances with a Heated Element
